What are Cosmetic Injectables?

As we age, we begin to lose our ability to produce new elastin, collagen and hyaluronic acid in the skin. At the same time, we experience a loss of facial and lip volume. You can prevent and reduce the effect of wrinkles with cosmetic injectables.

Whether it's a line you'd like smoothed over, or a bump that needs to be balanced, cosmetic injectables can help you achieve your aesthetic goals. Bite Dental has partnered with Dr Axell Jones, to bring you a range of professional treatments, including anti-wrinkle injections and dermal fillers.

Dr Axell understands the science behind ageing, and with facial analysis can recommend a cosmetic injection treatment for a fresher you.

What are the differences between muscle relaxants and dermal fillers?

Muscle relaxants are used to treat wrinkles and lines caused by repeated muscle movement, such as smile lines and forehead creases. They work by temporarily weakening and essentially freezing the underlying muscles. Dermal fillers are used to plump up the skin by adding volume in specific areas of the face. They can be used by Dr Axell to:

- fill in wrinkles caused by sagging skin
- restore volume lost to the ageing process
- to enhance areas of the face such as the lips or cheeks

Some of our patients opt to undergo a combination treatment of both products for optimal effects. The results of dermal fillers tend to be visible immediately and can last anywhere from 6-12 months. The results of muscle relaxants will take approximately a week to appear and will typically last 3-6 months.



Which facial areas can be treated?

Muscle relaxants and dermal fillers have been used successfully to treat most areas of the face. Our treatments are suitable for facial enhancement, filling in lines, wrinkles, and depressions, and smoothing wrinkles caused by facial muscle movement. Common treatment areas include:

- Forehead wrinkles
- Frown lines
- Crow's feet
- Jawline
- Chin
- Marionette lines
- Lips
- Smile lines

Will people know I've had treatment?

Here at Bite Dental our goal is to create natural-looking enhancements. Often, people who know you well will remark that you look healthier, well rested and refreshed. Dr Axell is able to avoid the "overdone", obvious, or unnatural look that often occurs when too much product is injected.



Can injectables relieve my excess sweating?

Excessive sweating can affect any body part, including the underarms, the palms, the soles of the feet, and the face.

Until now, most treatments for excessive sweating were often ineffective, short-acting or had significant risks. For those suffering from excessive sweating, these treatments give them new hope where previous therapies have failed before.

By blocking the release of acetylcholine, which activates the sweat glands, muscle relaxants can relieve excessive sweating. Previous treatments for excessive sweating for the underarms were often ineffective and short-acting or were associated with significant risks.

Studies have shown that 80 to 95% of patients respond to one treatment session (*Naumann 2001; Lowe 2003; Naumann 2003*).

How could muscle relaxant treatment help my headaches, jaw tension, and teeth grinding?

TMD or Temporomandibular Joint Disorder is an acute or chronic inflammation of the temporomandibular joint (TMJ; the joint connecting the lower jaw to the skull). The disorder and resultant dysfunction results in significant pain and impairment for many.

Increasingly, muscle relaxing injections are used as an alternative treatment for TMJ disorders, migraines, jaw tension and pain. This often reduces headaches resulting from teeth grinding and muscle spasm.



How much do cosmetic injectables cost?
